The primary responsibilities of this position require extensive prior experience conducting research on the associational life of immigrant groups, primarily from Latin American countries. Extensive knowledge of immigration theory and international development, as it relates to the sending countries and the host countries, ability to conduct extensive fieldwork, both in the U.S. and internationally, involving interviews with immigrant organization leaders, members, and consulate officials, survey design, data gathering and synthesis. Under the direction of the Principal Investigator, this individual will oversee and coordinate the activities of research teams comprised of graduate students and professional researchers.

This position requires a Ph.D. in Sociology as well as a minimum of five years post-doctoral research experience, proven history of publication in the fields of immigration theory and international development, demonstrated ability to assemble and maintain inventories and databases of transnational organizations both domestic and international and fluency in Spanish. Additional requirements include knowledge of Microsoft Office applications, SPSS, STATA and Atlas.
